

ACT for the Disappeared (ACT) was founded in 2010 as a Lebanese human rights association seeking to support Lebanese family associations working on the issue of the disappeared. ACT's main objectives are to provide recognition and reparation for families of the disappeared and contribute to the clarification of the fate of the missing. It also aims to develop understanding about the issue of the disappeared among the youth and address Lebanon' vulnerability to repeated cycles of violence. ACT's activities consist mainly of psycho-social activities, the development of an interactive digital memorial for the missing as well as an investigative project on the fate of the missing. ACT is a member of the International Coalition of Sites of Conscience since 2014.
